Club Rules

General:

1. Any persons that enter the club or makes use of our facilities, does so at his/her own risk.
2. Children under the age of 18 years must ride with a protective riding hat/helmet and closed shoes (with a heel).
3. Only club members are permitted to keep, ride, and use their horses on the club premises at own risk.
4. Non-members may only ride or work with horses in the presence of the horse's owner, who is a member, or when getting a riding lesson with an instructor that is also a club member.
5. No riding in the stable area.
6. Treat each other and each other's horses with respect.

Camps & grazing:

7. Horses must be put back in the same grazing paddocks that they were taken out of. Horses may only be put in other paddocks with the permission of the Stable Master.
8. The two riding paddocks/arenas in front of the club may only be used for grazing when the owner is present to immediately remove the horse(s) when a rider wishes to use the paddock/arena or with permission of the Stable Master.
9. The wash bay may only be used for hosing down or washing.

Health & Care

10. Owners will be liable for all vet fees incurred, whether at the request of the owner or the discretion of the Stable Master and by a committee member. These fees include: compulsory three-monthly deworming, compulsory yearly vaccinations and flu vaccinations.
11. Owners are at all times expected to take care of their horse's wellbeing properly. This includes but is not limited to water and feed in stables, maintenance of hooves and general condition



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Club Rules (continued)

Movement:

12. Members must log all in- and out movements of horses on the list on the notice board.
13. One calendar months' written notice must be given when a horse is to be removed from the club. Owners will be liable for costs if proper notice is not given.
14. Applications to bring a horse to the club must be done in writing. Application forms is available from the Stable Master and must be accompanied by a certificate of health and/or copies of the horse's passport. Only after application has been approved by the committee, may horse be brought to the clubs' premises.
15. Written application must be done to change stables. No horse may be moved to another stable without the permission of the Stable Master.

Personnel

16. Club personnel reports to the committee. No member may give Jackson or other personnel members orders or assignments without the Stable Masters consent.

Equipment

17. Equipment may only be used with the Stable Masters permission.
18. Use of equipment is at own risk.
19. Members are responsible to return equipment back to the store room after use.
20. Any disputes or uncertainties will be dealt with by the committee according to their discretion.
